Within hours of learning in March that Philadelphia schools would close because of COVID Lyra staff retrieved harps from schools and the Kimmel Center, hand-delivering over 20 harps to our students' homes. COVID Has not been a barrier to teaching! Lyra has given over 200 virtual lessons and classes, and provided scholarships for two virtual summer programs, free to our students: Curtis Summerfest Harp Colony in partnership with Curtis Institute of Music; and All City Orchestra Summer Academy in partnership with The Mann.
